"You have fully known" = "you have followed closely"
A. v.10,11 Nine Aspects of Paul's Life Fully Known by Timothy

2. His <u>conduct</u> (ἀγωγή/agoge), WAY OF LIFE.
3. His <u>purpose</u> , TO FULFILL GOD'S DESIGN FOR HIM.

5. His <u>longsuffering</u> (μακροθυμία/makrothumia), PATIENCE WITH

II. 3:14,15 THE EXAMPLE OF GODLY PARENTS (Timothy's Heritage)
A. v.14 The Charge: " in your orientation."
Encouragement to be comfortable, at home with what he knew.
B. v.15 The Fact of Timothy's Biblical Heritage
- "from a <u>child</u> " = βρεφος / brephos = a, a!
- "the holy scriptures" - words reserved by Jews and Christians for the

Paul reminds us that it is only the Word of God and the Spirit of God that can accomplish the will of God.
