Conclusions: Christ, Whose Son is He?

1.	Humanly, Jesus, the Christ, is the son of Mary the virgin, conceived miraculously by God.
2.	Divinely, Jesus is the eternal Son of God who became flesh in the
3.	The Son of God like the Father is eternal.
4.	The Son of God did not become so by generation in time: He is the Son by (as is the Father).
	-the Father is the fullness of God invisible
	-the Son is the fullness of God manifested
	-the Holy Spirit is the fullness of God acting upon the creature, 1Cor. 2:9-12.
5.	The terms Father, Son, & Holy Spirit are best understood as
